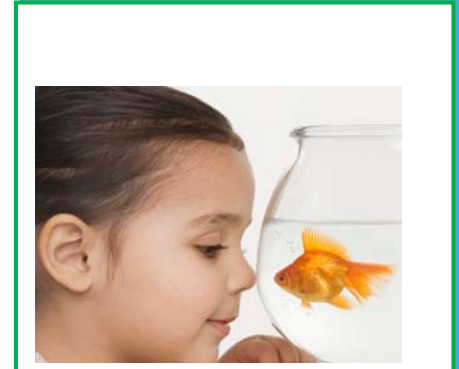
The Curious Child.....

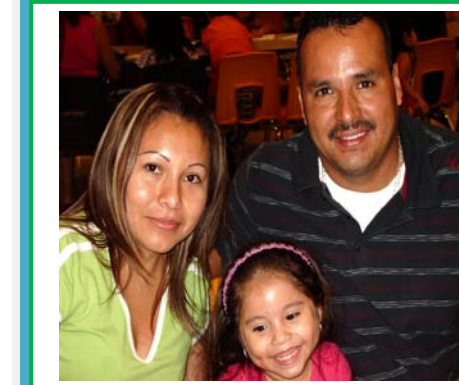

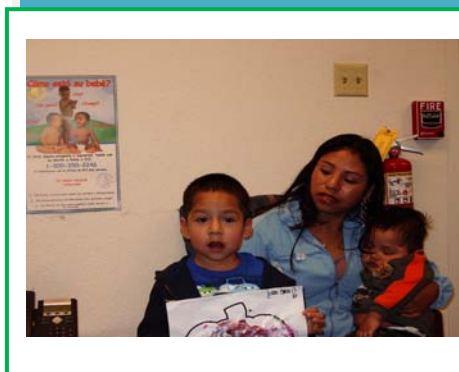
