

Grade 1 - Mathematics

First graders will:

- Use whole numbers up to 99 to describe and compare quantities
- Use the terms less than, greater than, and equal to
- Divide a whole into equal parts and use appropriate language to describe a part (i.e. “Three (3) out of four (4) crayons are red.”)
- Use estimation strategies
- Identify patterns and their relationships in classifying and organizing information
- Identify, compare, and contrast shapes and solids
- Combine geometric shapes to create new shapes in drawing activities
- Investigate measurement concepts
- Describe temperatures as hot or cold
- Describe time in hours and half hours
- Use words and numbers to describe the value of pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters
- Solve real-world application problems to connect the abstract and concrete
- Use drawing a picture as a problem solving strategy
- Relate everyday language to mathematics
