

# **Interactive Word Walls**

## **Mind Reader:**

Students number paper & put guess each time a clue is given...

First Clue: It is a word on the word wall

Second Clue: It is a word that has two syllables.

Third Clue: It is a word that uses one of the other words to form.

Fourth Clue: Scientists are 'observing' changes of one of these in Mississippi.

Fifth Clue: The word will complete this sentence...

A \_\_\_\_\_ is formed when sediments are dropped at the mouth of a river.

## **TIC TAC TOE**

Choose nine of the word wall words and put in a tic tac toe box. When I read the definition of the word and you have it, place a X on the word. When you have a tic tac toe, let us all know!

## **Hot Seat**

A student comes to the front and is in the 'hot seat'. They are allowed to ask Yes/No questions to try and guess the word wall word the teacher or classmate has chosen.

Sample questions:

Is it round?

Does it have more than 10 letters?

Would this word be found near the beginning of the dictionary?

Is it living?

Is it bigger than a fox?

Does it live in the rain forest?

Does the word mean....<definition of the word>

Keep a tally of how many questions it took them to guess the right word. The fewest number wins.
